

ACCOMMODATION

We offer some rooms to students arriving in September or in January/February. They are located in Paris. Monthly rent: 330€-700€.

Financial support:

All students are eligible for housing aid (around 30% of the rent) paid by the <u>CAF</u> - Caisse d'Allocations familiales - if they open a local bank account.

CLINICAL ROTATIONS

Application deadline:

5 months prior to the required start day.

Procedure:

All requests of internship must be submitted to Estelle Masse estelle.masse@sorbonne-universite.fr.

The students are kindly asked not to contact hospital departments directly!

Language requirements:

At least B2 (CEFR) level of French or English is required.

PLEASE NOTE

The minimum duration of internship is 1 month. The duration per week is 20/25 hours.

Students coming from non-EU countries are only allowed to do observatory internships.
